Sausage Pinwheels

1 pound ground sausage
1 (8-ounce) package cream cheese, softened
1 teaspoon garlic powder
1/4 cup chopped green onions
1 (8-count) package crescent rolls
Instructions

Instructions

Cook the sausage over medium heat in a skillet, breaking it up with a spatula as it cooks.

Drain off any excess grease. In a medium bowl, combine the cream cheese, garlic powder, and green onions. Stir until well combined.

Unroll the crescent rolls and place them on a piece of parchment paper. Do not separate the rolls.

Spread the sausage mixture over the crescent rolls, leaving a 1-inch border around the edges.

Starting from the long side, roll up the crescent rolls tightly.

Wrap the roll in the parchment paper and then in plastic wrap. Freeze for at least 1 hour.

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).

Remove the roll from the freezer and unwrap it. Cut the roll into 1/4-inch thick slices.

Place the slices on a baking sheet lined with parchment paper.

Bake for 10-12 minutes, or until golden brown.


Kim is the new Postmaster at the Riverdale Post Office. We are all welcoming her with open arms since we haven't had our very own postmaster since Amy Orth.

Dr. Krysta Sellers and her husband Jason purchased Joy Dental Design in December 2022.

Hazen Smiles is the name of the new dental office which is located at Main Street and 2nd Ave NE, Hazen ND. Dr. Krysta Sellers worked full time for Joy Dental in the summer of 2016, prior to opening her own practice at the Aesthetic Dental Center in Bismarck. "I like the small-town warmth and welcoming nature of the people of Hazen," she said. "When I heard of the opportunity to purchase the Hazen dental practice, I immediately became interested." Krysta said having that connection with the staff of Joy Dental, and with the community as a whole, was how the

Sellers got involved in discussions and ultimately ended up making the purchase.

The Sellers closed on the purchase Dec. 29, although Jason said they view Jan. 1 as the real opening day. Jason Sellers is the owner of several mattress stores in North Dakota, as well as with his wife's dental practice. He said that he will largely oversee the management and publicity side of Hazen Smiles. "I understand business, so I'll run the business side of things, and leave the dentist expertise to my wife," Jason said.

That partnership will come in handy as the Sellers navigate both

the daily activities of their new enterprise and balancing the completion of the recent renovations.

"The dental practice has been in Hazen for over 50 years, and the building needed some updates so the community can have the practice for another 50 years," Krysta said. "We want to build something that the community can be proud of and we can be proud of, and really provide state-of-the-art dental services," Jason said. Despite these changes, Krysta said that the services are largely the same, with the possibility of adding teeth whitening at some point. The are hoping to hire an additional dental hygienist. Jason said they will remain on top of changes in dental technology. "One thing we do really well is if there is a new treatment and technology that comes out, we make that part of our continuing education that our staff goes through," he said.

"We can adjust if another advancement comes up.

We will try to be the most current and provide the best experience for people when they come see us."

Krysta said she has been so excited to begin this new part of her career, dedicated to brightening up smiles.

"I just like to see people smile and to really affect their lives," she said. She began practicing dentistry in Dickinson in 2011, before her time in Hazen and then opening her practice in Bismarck.

Krysta said Aesthetic Dental Center specializes in tooth aesthetics and rebuilding lost teeth. Jason added that one advantage of the purchase is that, if a Hazen resident needs this kind of specialized care, it will make the referral process for Bismarck as smooth as possible.

The Sellers have two children: an 8-year-old daughter Ella and a 5-year-old son Brecken. Krysta said they keep very busy, both with their work and with Ella's figure skating events, but also enjoy boating and fishing in the summer. They recently started doing some skiing in the winter. In addition to her time with Joy Dental in Hazen, Krysta said she has extended family in Beulah, so she is familiar with the area. Jason said Hazen Smiles plans to have a grand opening,

but a date has not been set at this point.
