Honor Flight April, 2022







Deer Gun Season Opens Nov. 10

North Dakota's deer gun season, arguably the state's most anticipated and celebrated hunting season, opens Nov. 10 at noon Central time.

The Game and Fish Department's standardized opening day of North Dakota's deer gun season is determined by the calendar and always opens the Friday immediately preceding Veterans Day, Nov. 11. This is to ensure that the opening day of North Dakota's deer gun season does not occur on the federal holiday.

The last time the opener of the 16 ½-day season fell on the second weekend in November and ran through Thanksgiving was 2018.

Deer Hunters Should be Aware of Early Ice

North Dakota's deer gun season opens Nov. 10 at 12 p.m. Central time, and the state Game and Fish Department cautions deer hunters to be wary of ice conditions.

In some parts of the state, there are already smaller and mid-sized waters that show the appearance of safe ice. Even though deer might be able to make it across, it doesn't mean hunters can.

Ice can form overnight, causing unstable conditions. Ice thickness is not consistent, as it can vary significantly within a few inches. Hunters walking the edge of a cattail slough will not find the same ice thickness in the middle, as the edges firm up faster than farther out from shore.

Hunters should be cautious of walking on frozen stock ponds, sloughs, creeks and rivers. A few reminders:

- Snow insulates ice, which in turn inhibits solid ice formation, and hides cracks, weak and open water areas.
- Avoid cracks, pressure ridges, slushy or darker areas that signal thinner ice. The same goes for ice that forms around partially submerged trees, brush, embankments or other structures.
- Daily temperature changes cause ice to expand and contract, affecting its strength.

6:36 p.m. - Take aim.


6:37 p.m. — Fire gun, blow up barrel plugged with mud.

WESTERN NORTH DAKOTA HONOR FLIGHT

Honor flights began in 2005 as a way to give back to America's Veterans. Since its 'beginning more than 200,000 veterans of WW II, Korea and Vietnam have been given the chance to visit the memorials dedicated to their service, located in Washington D.C. North Dakota joined in April 2022 and this was the third flight. The program is funded by foundation donations and various fundraisers. The program can function as it does because of volunteers. I had enrolled in the program early this spring and was expecting to participate around the middle of October. However, Friday night September 29, I received a call telling me that due to some cancellations a seat had opened and would I like to fly out Sunday morning Oct 1 at 5 AM. Made it. They sent me a list of does and don't, documents I should have and the itinerary. We flew into Baltimore on Sunday morning and were bussed into D.C. Before leaving Bismarck, we had been divided into color coded groups. There was 112 Veterans and about 25 Volunteers. No time was wasted as we approached D.C. driving around the central part and seeing what was to come. First stop(s) included the Lincoln Memorial, Korean Memorial and the Viet Nam memorial. With one or two exceptions all of us were VN veterans. The Viet Nam memorial is a very emotional place to visit. I would like to thank Keli for the help for myself and another Vet through this... Hour and a half later back on your color-coded bus for a trip to Arlington Cemetary where we watched the changing of the guard ceremony and four Veterans were involved in the wreathing placing ceremony. Our next stop was the Marine Corps Memorial (The raising of the flag at Iwo Jima) and the last of the day was the Air Force Memorial. From there to the Hotel. Free time until the 6.30 Banquet and social hour. Monday started a

From there to the Hotel. Free time until the 6.30 Banquet and social hour. Monday started a 6.30 with breakfast and loading luggage on the bus. We boarded at 7.30 by color and set off for the Capitol Building. Processing through security was easier than I thought it would be but still a screening process. At some point in there we had a group picture on the Capitol steps.

We had been given and were asked to all wear the blue Honor Flight tee shirts for this and the tour.

Guess they didn't want to lose anyone in the Capitol Building. We left the capitol about 11 and traveled to the U.S.Navy Memorial (lunch on the bus. then on to the WW II memorial followed by the FDR and MLK memorials. At 2.15 we left D.C. for Baltimore. Our flight was about 30 min late leaving (waiting for the catering truck which never showed) no dinner.

Back in Bismarck shortly after 7 almost right on time. The reception at the Bismarck airport came as a complete surprise to me as I had not been to the preflight meeting two weeks earlier. About 300 people greeted us waving signs and clapping, shaking hands and giving hugs. The Century High School band greeted us with theme songs of the various military branches. It was an extremely moving time no dry eyes here. The outpouring of caring was a type of healing that was long overdue. Thanks to all to participate and those who made it possible. A special thanks to the volunteers that had our back as we walked to and from the memorials as

it seemed everything was built on a hill.


