On the Brink



“HO-HO-HO HIKE, A Holiday Adventure”

The North Country Trail Association’s Central Flyway Chapter and The Friends of Audubon Refuge are sponsoring a **“guided hike”** on **December 19, 2021 at 2:00 pm** and a **“self-guided hike”** from **December 20, 2021 through January 1, 2022.**

The hike is 2 miles long and follows along the Refuge’s Prairie Nature Trail as well as the new sections of the North Country Trail. The trails surfaces are concrete, mowed grass, and gravel.

The hiking trail will be well marked with signs depicting the *12 Days of Christmas and our new Holiday Traditions.* The hike begins at the parking lot of the Refuge Visitor’s Center.

The North Country Trail portion of the hike will be marked with candy canes, and the Prairie Nature Trail will have the Twelve Days of Christmas Signs. In the wooded area of the trail (within the first half mile) you will learn all about the history of some of our country’s most popular Christmas Traditions.

We will have a bird friendly decorated Christmas tree in the holiday traditions segment of the hike, so if you would like to bring a bird friendly ornament please check our facebook pages listed below for suggestions.

We realize the weather in North Dakota dictates whether or not these winter events can take place, so please check our Facebook Pages: **NCTA Central Flyway Chapter** or **Audubon Refuge Partners, Inc,** for updates about the trail conditions and the guided hike in particular.

There is no entry fee for the hike or for entrance into the refuge. The address for the refuge is **3098 11th St NW, Coleharbor, ND**

Tentative 2022 Season Opening Dates

The North Dakota Game and Fish Department annually provides its best estimate for opening dates to help hunters prepare for hunting seasons.

Dates become official when approved by governor's proclamation. Tentative opening dates for 2022 include:

Spring Turkey	April 9
Dove	September 1
Deer and Pronghorn Bow, Mountain Lion	September 2
Sharptail, Hun, Ruffed Grouse, Squirrel	September 10
Youth Deer	September 16
Youth Waterfowl	September 17
Early Resident Waterfowl	September 24
Youth Pheasant, Regular Waterfowl	October 1
Pronghorn Gun	October 7
Pheasant, Fall Turkey	October 8
Mink, Muskrat, Weasel Trapping	October 22
Deer Gun	November 4
Deer Muzzleloader	November 25

Coyote Catalog Available

The North Dakota Game and Fish Department and North Dakota Department of Agriculture are again opening the Coyote Catalog, a statewide effort designed to connect committed hunters and trappers with landowners who are dealing with coyotes in their areas.

[Landowners can sign up](https://nd.gov/ndda/) on the Department of Agriculture website, nd.gov/ndda/.

[Hunters and trappers can sign up](https://gf.nd.gov/) at the Game and Fish website, gf.nd.gov.

Anyone who registered for the Coyote Catalog in the past must register again to activate their names on the database.

Throughout winter, hunters or trappers may receive information on participating landowners, and they should contact landowners to make arrangements.

Landowners experiencing coyote depredation of livestock should first contact the U.S. Department of Agriculture Wildlife Services.

The Coyote Catalog will remain active through March 31.
