WRT Board of Director Opportunities in 2023

WRT is a local cooperative providing fiber optic broadband internet, voice, and security camera services, as well as Co-Op Cashback to members in 25 communities across central North Dakota and South Dakota. WRT is currently accepting Board of Director petitions for two positions open in 2023.

WRT's service area is divided into seven districts, with representation by one director for each district. Directors are elected, by the WRT membership, to serve three-year terms and may run for re-election. WRT members living in District 4 or District 7 wishing to run for the cooperative board can do so by submitting a petition for nomination. Petitions must be signed by at least 15 WRT members and submitted by 5:00pm CT on Friday, March 3, 2023, in accordance with WRT Bylaws.

The current WRT members representing the open positions are District 4 Director Joy Kitzan, Hebron, and District 7 Director Gene Wolf, Hazen. WRT members living in District 4 and District 7 can represent their local area on the cooperative board. WRT District 4 consists of parts of Morton and Stark Counties in North Dakota including the parts of the St. Anthony, Flasher, New Salem, Glen Ullin, and Hebron exchanges lying within those counties south of Interstate 94. WRT District 7 consists of parts of Mercer County in North Dakota including the parts of the Hazen, Stanton, Pick City, and Center exchanges lying within Mercer County.

The election will take place at WRT's 71st Annual Meeting on Friday, June 2, 2023, in Hazen. Any WRT member may vote for the two director positions electronically via online voting, by mail/absentee ballot, in person at the Annual Meeting registration, or during the Annual Meeting. Online voting and mail/absentee will be available prior to WRT's annual meeting. Members interested in running for the WRT Board should contact WRT CEO/GM Troy Schilling at the WRT Hazen office, email myWRT@wrtc.com or call 701-748-2211 to request a petition. Additional information can be found in the WRT telephone book.



- royal icing eyes
- micro heart sprinkles

Line baking sheet with parchment paper/silpat mat. In a microwave safe bowl, add red candy wafers. Microwave on medium heat for 30 seconds. Remove and stir slowly. Replace in microwave for 15 second increments until candy wafers are completely melted. Dip Oreo cookie three-fourths of the way into the melted red chocolate and lightly tap to remove excess chocolate; transfer to parchment paper and immediately add Valentine's Day sprinkles.
