FOR MANY YEARS THE FIRST SIGN OF SPRING IN RIVERDALE, NORTH DAKOTA, IS THE RETURN OF SNOW BIRDS AND CAMPERS. IN 2010 THE RIVERDALE CITY COUNCIL CHANGED THE CAMP CONTRACT FROM WEEKLY GUESTS TO A FIVE-MONTH LEASE WITH UTILITY AND WATER FEES, PERFECT FOR THOSE SEEKING THE COOLER BREEZES OF A NORTH DAKOTA SUMMER.

THIS CHANGE, THOUGH NOT AS DEMOCRATIC AS OTHER AREA CAMPS, PROVIDES A NEIGHBORHOOD FEEL TO THE CAMPGROUND WITH MANY GUESTS RETURNING EVERY YEAR. THEN TOO, CAMPERS HAVE PURCHASED REAL ESTATE IN RIVERDALE, WHICH IS AN OBVIOUS PLUS.

Today the campground has 45 full hook-up spots and 66 sites that do not have sewer. These sites are rented from 5/15/23-9/30/23. The campers maintain their own lots and the city maintains the public area of the campground. The sites are rented out at the rate of \$1,450 for full hookup and \$1,225 for the sites that lack sewer. These campers are also responsible to pay electricity and water that is used by the campground each season. Last year that bill totaled about \$185 per site.

What does this mean for the City of Riverdale and the residents? It definitely brings in some revenue for the city and helps the local businesses. We all know Riverdale is pretty quiet over the winter months. It's a great opportunity for the full-time time residents to have businesses that we may not otherwise have. Terry & Kim Morast are the managers of the campground. Terry is full time and has been the manager since 2014. They take care of any concerns that may come up. They also encourage the campers to support the local business by letting them know what is available. I was a camper myself until we bought our home in 2013 and next thing I knew, we were living here full-time. The campers keep the value of the homes in Riverdale in a hot market. There is a waiting list to get into the Morning Star campground. In summary, these are a few reasons we are happy we have a campground in Riverdale.

INGREDIENTS

CRUST

1 CUP ALL-PURPOSE FLOUR
1/2 CUP SUGAR
1/2 CUP BUTTER, ROOM TEMPERATURE

FILLING

2 LARGE EGGS
1 CUP SUGAR
1/4 CUP FLOUR
1/4 TSP. SALT
2 CUPS DICED RHUBARB

INSTRUCTIONS

PREHEAT OVEN TO 350F. LINE THE BOTTOM OF AN 8X8" PAN WITH PARCHMENT BRINGING IT UP THE SIDES SO THAT IT WILL BE EASY TO REMOVE THE SQUARES AFTER. WHIRL THE CRUST INGREDIENTS IN A FOOD PROCESSOR AND THEN PRESS INTO THE PREPARED PAN. BAKE FOR 15 MIN., CRUST WILL STILL REMAIN VERY PALE IN COLOR.

WHILE CRUST IS BAKING MIX TOGETHER EGGS, SUGAR, FLOUR AND SALT AND WHISK WELL. STIR IN RHUBARB. POUR ONTO THE HOT CRUST AND CONTINUE TO BAKE FOR 40-45MIN. LET THE BARS COOL AND REMOVE WITH THE PARCHMENT PAPER. CUT INTO SQUARES.

Bait Regulations

Anglers should note that live white suckers are not legal baitfish in North Dakota, except in the Bois de Sioux and Red rivers. Anglers can use live white suckers on the Bois de Sioux and Red rivers, and tributaries up to the first vehicular bridge; however, they are illegal elsewhere. Fathead minnows, sticklebacks and creek chubs are the only legal live baitfish outside of the Bois de Sioux and Red rivers. The transportation of live white suckers, other than in Richland, Cass, Traill, Grand Forks, Walsh and Pembina counties, is illegal. In addition, it is illegal for anglers to import minnows and other forms of live aquatic bait, such as leeches and frogs, into North Dakota. When purchasing live aquatic bait, anglers must buy from a licensed North Dakota retail bait vendor. Bait vendors can properly identify species and ensure all bait is clean of any aquatic nuisance species. For more information, refer to the 2022-24 North Dakota Fishing Guide, available at license vendors or online at the state Game and Fish Department website, gf.nd.gov.

Tips When Launching, Loading Boats

The North Dakota Game and Fish Department encourages boaters to plan accordingly when launching and loading a boat. Here are a few simple reminders to ensure a fluent transition at the ramp.

Launching

- Don't pull onto the ramp until your boat is ready to launch.
- Prepare for launching in the parking area. Remove covers, load equipment, remove tie downs, attach lines and put in drain plug before backing onto the ramp.
- When ready, pull in line to launch. Wait your turn. Be courteous.

Loading

- Don't block the loading area with your boat until your tow vehicle is ready to load. Wait until you are clear of the launch area to unload gear.
- As soon as your trailer is in the water, load and secure your boat to the trailer.
 - Remove boat and trailer from the water as quickly as possible.
- Get clear of the ramp. Pull into the parking area to finish securing your boat, unload gear, drain all water and inspect for and removing any vegetation. Remember to leave plugs out when transporting your boat.
